

SUPER BOWL SQUARES

100 squares · 21 x 15 in · AWAY across the top, HOME down the side · fantasydailies.com

1. TAPE THE GRID

Four sheets, two across and two down, printed side up. Butt the edges at the crop marks. Tape the back of each seam. Each sheet says what it goes next to.

2. SELL ALL 100 SQUARES FIRST

People write their name in an empty box. Any box. It does not matter which one, and that is the whole idea - nobody knows what they are buying yet.

3. ONLY THEN, DRAW THE NUMBERS

Cut out the twenty number tiles on the last sheet. Fold them. Put them in a hat, a bowl, a shoe. Draw them one at a time and tape them down: across the top first, then down the left.

4. DO NOT DO THIS IN THE WRONG ORDER

If the numbers go up before the squares are sold, the person who takes 7-0 knows exactly what he is doing, and by halftime everybody else knows it too.

HOW IT PAYS

Take the last digit of each team's score. Find the column and the row. That square wins.

Usually paid at the end of each quarter. A common split is 20% / 20% / 20% / 40% for the final, but it is your pool and your rules.

THE PERSON WITH THE PEN

Somebody has to hold the marker, draw the numbers, remember who paid, and settle it afterwards. Everyone has to trust that person completely.

Consider carefully whether your group contains that person.

OR, AND WE ARE JUST SAYING

We will run this for you, free, at fantasydailies.com/box-create.html - the numbers draw themselves in front of everyone, the grid updates live on all 100 phones, nobody has to be trusted with anything, and it does not live on one guy's wall where nobody can see it.

But if you have already printed this: respect. Get the tape.

THE NUMBERS

Cut these out AFTER all 100 squares are sold. Fold them, put them in something, draw them one at a time.
Top row first, left to right. Then the left column, top to bottom. Tape each one down as it comes out.

ACROSS THE TOP — AWAY
